

Moral Training List

The following list of virtues can be used to help the moral training of your children. This list is from a memory verse program used by Pastor Harris. The verses point out specific moral virtues that should be taken to heart by the parent and taught to the child(ren) (Deut. 6:6-7). Memorization is very helpful to instill these truths into the heart (Psalm 119:9-11). Two verses are printed out with additional verses listed on the same subject for further training on that topic. The subjects are grouped, but are not in any particular order of importance. Younger children can be taught a simplified version of a verse while older children can be challenged to memorize additional verses. One way to help implement learning these virtues is to post a Verse of the Day or Verse of the Week and work on memorization as a family. Be pro-active in instilling moral virtues into your children. (Verses are from the NASB as an example, but you can easily reproduce this list in other translations).

LOVE OF GOD

Deuteronomy 6:5, *“You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.”*

1 John 4:19, *“We love, because He first loved us.”*

Love of Others

Matthew 22:39, *“The second is like it, ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’”*

HUMILITY
