

Bible Reading Chart

There are 1,189 chapters in the Bible. If you read an average of 23 chapters per week (just over 3 chapters per day) you will read through the entire Bible in one year. Mark off or highlight each chapter you read. The chart below is in the standard arrangement, but you can also use one of the other methods found on the reverse side of this sheet - read according to chronology, or some from the Old Testament and some from the New Testament each day. You can read according to a set number of chapters per day or according to context as you decide.

Variations

*Read from both Old & New Testaments daily by Standard or Chronological order.

* Include a chapter of Proverbs every day & you will read it through 12 times / year.

* Include a Psalm a day & You will read it through 2 ½ / year

*Make up your own variation, but read consistently & daily. Make it a habit of your life.

(Notes: NT chronology is by conservative scholars. John is with the gospels because it covers that period. Luke is placed after it so that Acts immediately follows. Epistles are placed within relative timing of Acts).
