Pastors' Annual Report - Year 2023 (January - August)

With the change in the church's fiscal year to January 1 - August 31, this report only covers eight months. This change not only makes it easier to budget our school year ministries, but also avoid the time stress of trying to do all of the year end planning and report during the busy holiday season. The 2023 Statistical & Activities Report below highlights my ministry involvement and also chronicles the special guests and church activities that have occurred at GBC in the first eight months of 2023. I completed 32 years of ministry at Grace Bible Church this past April.

It have always considered it an honor and privilege to serve the Lord as pastor of Grace Bible Church and to teach and preach God's word. In the first eight months of 2023 I was able to finish preaching through 1 Peter and get half way through the series on Daniel. This year my preaching schedule also included 9 days in the Dominican Republic where I conducted seminars on Biblical Hermeneutics, Leadership and family as well as preach. Several factors including my being on a Sabbatical for parts of June and July resulted in an unusually large number of other men filling the GBC pulpit. Jonathan Harris preached three times - in February when I was at the Council of Regional Presidents meeting, and twice in July when I was on Sabbatical and then in the Dominican Republic. Both Ed Colón and Phil Jordan filled in for me while I was at the Shepherd's Conference and then again when I was on Sabbatical and in the Dominican Republic. David Harris was up from Tennessee in June and preached on Biblical Integrity. This was followed by Missionary Tom Stiles (Arise! Ministries) on Father's Day. Our retired former Associate Pastor, Jim Zieger, also came out while I was on Sabbatical to preach on Unity, the Heart of God. In addition to preaching, I was able to complete teaching the Parenting Class in Sunday school and also a five week class on Moral Innocence. I also taught a Jr / Sr High Bible Class for our Homeschool Co-op. I enjoyed working though the Deacon training material with three men - Mark Artis, Alex Savas and Emmanuel Vargas.

I was on Sabbatical from June 16 to July 14. This included attending the IFCA Convention in Covington, KY at the end of June. Though there were times of relaxation and visiting David, Natasha and Jackie Lee along with the other GBC exiles in Tennessee, a sabbatical is also a time to work on special projects. Diane and I were able to complete a Discipler's Guide to using the One-to-One Discipling material. I was also able to map out a sermon schedule into 2025 preaching through sections of Old Testament prophets and Revelation.

Diane and I praise the Lord that her present level of medications for Stiff Person Syndrome has kept the symptoms to a minimum with very little progression of the disease. We feel confident that it is realistic for us to plan to be here into 2025. It is our prayer that God will supply a new man to follow me in that year to continue the strong ministry Grace Bible Church has had over the decades. It is our desire to be able to have at least a six month overlap with the new pastor so that he can become well acquainted with the congregation before assuming all of the ministry responsibilities that are part of pastoral ministry. Join in praying with us now for this to happen for it will not be an easy task to find a well qualified man with the necessary missionary heart to come to New York.

The ministry of GBC extends far outside the physical boundaries of our local church through email, our website, streaming, Zoom, Sermon Audio and social media. Our online ministries still remain very significant despite search engine changes that minimize our web presence. If you visit our website or any of our social media outlets, be sure to give us a "like," a "thumbs up" or high rating. We are grateful the Lord has allowed us to use these technologies to further our ministry for His glory. We are looking at ways to expand them, so if you can help put us on alternative social media to reach those audiences, please let me know. Tyler Jornov did a great service for us in quickly posting our past recorded sermons on Sermon Audio giving us a total of 1,164 sermons and teachings now posted.

Our average attendance figures are in the statistical report below. We seem to add new families about the same rate as other families move away from New York. While sorrowful for the departure of friends

and family, we rejoice in them being in places where they can continue to grow and serve, and we also rejoice in the opportunity to help new people know and walk with Christ and learn to serve Him here. Average viewership of sermons on internet platforms remains higher than those that physically attend demonstrating the importance of web based ministries and the reach of GBC. A little over 3,000 receive the text of the sermons weekly.

While giving is lower than the last couple of years, the Lord has continued to be most graciousness in meeting the financial needs of the church. The surplus from the last few years has allowed us to do several capital projects as noted in the Deacon Report and Treasurer's Report.

Our security teams have continued to keep GBC a safe place to be. Security involves not only preventing any physical threat from the outside, but also being able to help people with medical emergencies.

The homeschool community we started in Fall 2021 has grown in numbers and quality becoming an important part of our church family and ministry. Several of our new families are directly the result of this effort. Our school age families are becoming closer and stronger together.

Our missions team to the Dominican Republic was smaller this year consisting of Grace Thomas and Teresa Garcia teaching sewing, a ladies Bible study and helping with a children's outreach and Winston Bernal and me teaching seminars, doing personal encouragement of pastors and visiting ministries there that are new to us. We look forward to continuing to build those relationships and pursuit of a possible co-operative effort with International Training & Equipping Ministries (I.T.E.M.), a mission we support, that has just started working on the east end of the country.

I still hold the position of President of the NY State Regional of our church association, IFCA International. I am seeking to rebuild it by having monthly zoom meetings with the desire that will lead to being able to have in person meeting again in 2024.

I praise the Lord for the many faithful servants here at Grace Bible Church. Some of them are specifically named in the reports that follow, and many others minister behind the scene known only to the Lord and those blessed by them. I am especially blessed personally by those serving on the Advisory Council to the Elders, as Deacons, in our Women's Servant Council, and ministry leaders.

Society changes, but the purpose of Grace Bible Church remains the same. We strive to be as effective as possible in *Glorifying God by Making Disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ*. Every ministry of the church should reflect that purpose and fulfill one or more of our four goals: *Communicate New Life in Christ Through Evangelism; *Cultivate New Life in Christ Through Edification; *Care for New Life in Christ Through Fellowship and *Celebrate New Life in Christ Through Worship. Our commitment to this is even greater as we recognize the changing paradigms in our society and adjust to prepare the church to meet the challenges and remain faithful to Him in all circumstances.

May each of us continue to faithfully serve our Lord Jesus Christ in 2023 with many more joining so that we might reach our community and beyond with the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ and help one another become mature in Him.

Membership - 2023 began with 60 active and 6 inactive members and as of August 31 had 63 active and 12 inactive members and 3 are in process. members were added. members were removed.

Annual Deacon Report 2023

The scriptural qualification for the office of Deacon is defined in Acts 6:3 and 1 Timothy 3:8-13. Deacons are servants and are involved in carrying out the more practical aspects of church life so that the Elders can be free to lead and shepherd the flock that God has entrusted to their care. The duties of a Deacon are not specifically defined in Scripture, with that said, we serve at the discretion of the Elders as they see fit based on the needs of the congregation.

The men serving Pastor Harris and the congregation this past year were as follows: Dominic Bonasio, Ed Colon, Phil Jordan, Jim Phelan, Sam Ramac, Randy Ryan. Manny Alvarez, Mark Artis, and Alex Savas have been in the Deacon intern process and have completed the period of testing that scripture requires and will be voted upon as part of the annual business meeting.

One of the main responsibilities of the Deacons is the management/maintenance of the building and grounds. This is regularly addressed with the bi-annual workdays and addressing issues as needed throughout the year. We are grateful for all who take the time to come out for these workdays, and at other times, to maintain and improve what God has so graciously provided us. At the 2022 Annual business meeting I had stated that we didn't envision any major capital projects for 2023 such as was undertaken in 2022, but that didn't end up being the case. This year's major capital improvements were:

- The final steps were completed to have the new doors integrated into the access control system after they were replaced in 2022.
- A basketball court was installed in the early summer in the back field. The initial plan was for a half-court, but an individual in the church put forth the funds to make it a full court. The hope is that not only our own youth will use it but that it will be used to minister to others as well.
- It was decided that the parking area behind the church needed to be repaved and regraded due to the pavement breaking up and drainage issues. The process was not without issues but is now complete and we believe that besides now having a stable surface for someone who is handicapped to enter through the downstairs, the drainage issues have been improved.

As was mentioned in last year's report, we were going to look at ways to lessen Pastor Harris's load moving forward and to that end we met several times in the spring to see what could be done away with, done by others or outsourced. There has been some progress made, and we'll continue to look for ways to make further progress in the coming year.

Missions Report - 2023

Pastor Harris kept the congregation informed about missions and missionaries, both supported and friends, through regular *Missions Moments* updates in our regular worship services.

We were glad to be able send a small missions team to the Dominican Republic July 21-30, 2023. Grace Thomas and Teresa Garcia taught sewing classes to women, a ladies Bible study for them, and helped with a children's outreach. Pastor Harris & Winston Bernal taught Hermeneutics seminars at a Saturday retreat with follow up in local churches. Seminars on Leadership and Family were also taught as well the sermon on July 23. Pastor Harris & Winston also met with individual pastors and small groups to encourage them, find out about their vision for new ministries and see a rehabilitation ministry that is new to us. We rejoice in the new contacts and pray these will continue to expand. Pastor Harris is in contact with International Training and Equipping Ministry (I.T.E.M.), an missions organization that we support, and the possibility of co-operation with them as they open up a new field in the Dominican Republic.

We did not have any supported missionaries with us in the January - August 2023 time frame. We did have Tom Stiles, a long time missionary friend on Father's Day. Pastor Stiles directs *Arise! Ministries*

After 40 years of ministry, Christian Mission to the United Missions Community (CMUMC - Gary & Elaine Allen) is ceasing operation as a Non-Profit organization as of March 31, 2024. Government regulations have increased the administrative load on religious organizations which have made it a burden to the Allens. The Allens will be seeking to continue to minister in many of the same ways as they have as long as they can. As per our Missions Policy which views our missionaries as part of GBC, we will be picking up the administrative tasks of having funding come through our church. CMUNC will become a designated fund of GBC which can receive donations for the Allens that can then be sent to them to cover business & ministry expenses as well as salary.

- *We are in need of someone to take over posting the physical newsletter that come.

2023 Women s Discipleship Report

In 2023 we continued to promote discipleship among the women. We had many women go through the discipleship process with at least 14 in progress now. We also trained 7 new disciplers into the ministry. We currently have 20 women approved to disciple others.

For those unfamiliar with discipleship, it is neither a program nor a class. It is a relationship formed between a more mature Christian and a younger Christian to cause growth to them both. Although we use a tool, the core of discipleship is life to life, dealing with the personal issues of life and how those relate to the Word of God. This is paramount. Our favorite tool to use is the "One-to-One Discipleship" workbook which has 11 lessons on basic teachings on Christian belief and life. These lessons use Scripture to explain spiritual maturity, but spiritual growth is not merely head knowledge, but heart knowledge as well. The material also has assignments that develop Christian lifestyle habits such as Bible reading, memorizing Scripture, prayer and taking notes on sermons. The discipler helps the disciple understand and put into practice living for Christ in the various situations of life. Biblical principles and commands address every question that could come up. The discipleship pattern was set by Christ as He discipled 12 men, who later spread the gospel throughout the world.

It is a pleasure to see women grow! I am motivated by 2 Timothy 2:2 where Paul says: "These things, which you have heard from me, these entrust to faithful men who will be able to teach others also." This is the heart of discipleship, passing on the torch by spreading the Good News to all who will receive it and helping them walk with our Lord.

Five years ago, we completed the process of contracting with Multiplication Ministries to translate their English version of *One-To-One Discipleship* into Spanish for our Spanish Ministry at GBC. We are excited about being able to offer this solid material to our Spanish speaking disciples!

Our disciplers are all church members who have shared their testimonies of salvation to our leadership and our church. They are exemplary women who stand as examples to be mentoring others. Treasurer's Report - Grace Bible Church - for the 2023 Fiscal Year

Overview

The Lord is good! God provided abundantly in 2023. Total regular giving of \$ 171,272.18 more than enough to cover the \$165,175.98 that was spent from the general fund. \$141,444.63 of this was received through the Faith Box and checks. \$29,827.55 was received electronically. An additional \$16,412.83 was received in designated funds.

Regular Giving

Total regular giving (Check/Cash/Prolific & Dividends) was \$ 171,272.18 which is \$ 7,707.16 (4.31 %) below budget. Net (giving vs actual expenses) was \$5,096.20. Giving varied from month to month from a low of \$ 7,746.49 to a high of \$ 25,839.04 . Quarterly figures are:

General Expenses. Total General Expenses were 9.67% (\$ 17,686.68) below budget. Of note are: *Church Maintenance (\$5,037.06) included significant repairs to the Women's bathroom (\$460.77), electrical (\$450), Parking Lot (\$1,060), Heating lines (\$525) and sign repair (\$636.68 - not including graphic panels still being worked on. Parsonage maintenance included \$412.65 for stump grinding and landscaping.

Local Missions. Christian Education (\$563.34) does not reflect amount collected in registration fees for the GBC Homeschool Co-op which is a sub-category of Christian Education. The *Local Outreach* amount (\$2,132.02) has its major expenses incurred through August (Ulster County Fair). Men's Fellowship (gain of \$670.71) includes Men's Retreat, Men's Bible Study & Monthly Fellowship meetings. The Retreat had a neg gain of \$1,171.

Missionaries & Missions Organizations

The missionaries and missions organizations are paid on a quarterly basis. Their third quarter payment included July, August & September . The new fiscal budget only goes through August. The one month's excess will balance in the new fiscal year by a one month shortage. I.T.E.M. was paid through December.

Staff Compensation

The Minister of Evangelism had not submitted his Auto Mileage and Business Expenses as of the calculations for this report.

The Senior Pastor's FICA & Retirement are paid on a quarterly basis. Their third quarter payment included July, August & September . The new fiscal budget only goes through August. The one month's excess will balance in the new fiscal year by a one month shortage.

Capital Fund

This fund began the year at \$64,428.03 and ended with \$40,694.16 with an income of \$14,000 and expenses of \$37,733.87 (See the Funds Statement report for listing of how the funds were spent).

2023 Budget Proposal Notes

Overview:

The proposed regular budget for 2023/24 is \$267,5469.00 This is a spending decrease of \$900 (.34 %) from the 2023 budget. This is within the realm of standard formulas for projecting income, but with a \$7,707.16 total short fall in giving in the first eight months of 2023, it was thought best to be very conservative in this budget. A few items had minor cuts and couple some major cuts since there the anticipated need in the near future has dropped. A few items were increased to a minor modest degree due to current expenditure levels, and a couple of items were increased significantly due to anticipated increases in ministry. Current fund balances will be able to cover expenses if there is a shortfall in giving.

Our desire is to use the funds the Lord has provided to further His kingdom to the best of our ability. We know that persecution is coming, but we do not know when it will start or become severe enough to hinder our gospel work. Our priorities continue to reflect our the Grace Bible Church purpose statement of Glorifying God by Making Disciples of Jesus Christ. We desire to maximize our efforts in evangelism, discipleship and teaching ministries. As opportunities arise within any of these areas, this budget amount may be increased at future business meetings. We will also remain very flexible in spending on unforseen needs to carry out ministry as we have in past years. We will also maintain flexibility to meet benevolence needs as we have in past years.

General Expenses

Line items are generally set to reflect known or projected expenses. *Minor increases to Utilities in anticipation of continued cost increases. *Security has been reduced since there are no anticipated major equipment purchases in the next fiscal years.

Local Missions Expenses

Most line items remained the same and reductions were made were reasonably possible. Assimilation increase is to cover costs for moving membership class to a lunch after the morning service. Teen ministry requested an increase due to an increase in teens attending.

Missionaries & Missions Organizations:

The line items in these categories was left unchanged.

Compensation

The Minister of Evangelism amount increased to help cover inflation costs. He is looking for an additional part time job to help cover expenses. The salary/ expense increase will give him more flexibility on the number of hours he will need to work. If additional work prevents him to being able to continue his work as the Minister of Evangelism, this line item will be reduced.

The Sabbatical line item in the Senior Pastor's pay package was dropped since was a limited time budget item. The men requested a modest 3.23% salary increase. This is more than adequate for the Pastor's current financial situation.

Men's Discipleship Report - 2023

Discipleship is a core ministry at Grace Bible Church which occurs on various levels and is focused on the third aspect of the Great Commission. Our "teaching" ministry occurs in large groups such as Sunday Morning Worship, small groups such as our Bible Studies, and individually, both formally and informally. Most individual discipleship occurs informally as we exercise the one-anothering commands of scripture, but we also have a formal One-to-One Discipleship program which is designed to accelerate Christian growth and train Christians to help others grow as well. During 2022 there were approximately fifty-one men that attended GBC on a regular basis; twenty-four of them have completed the one-to-one discipleship (47%). During the past year 8 men (including CIA students) were in the one-to-one discipleship process; six of them completed the material; two are still in process.

Also in 2023, a Saturday morning men's group continued to meet, completing a study on the letter to the Hebrews and beginning a study in the first letter to the Corinthians. A monthly Men's Fellowship luncheon continues to be held on the 2nd Sunday of the month.

2023 Website / Social Media Report

The internet ministry of Grace Bible Church is very significant in reaching multiple thousands of people far beyond our geographical limitations. We praise the Lord for the ability to teach others and encourage them in walking with Christ locally, nationally, and internationally. All praise and glory be to our merciful and gracious God!

We have many people involved in our various internet based ministries. I do most of the posting on the GraceBibleNY.Org site. Rod Schools posts sermons to sermonaudio and I post classes there. Jim Phelan is our webmaster keeping up the technical aspects. Dominic Bonasio does most of the work with the facebook page. Phil Jordan oversees a team of people involved in our audio and streaming which requires people to work the sound board and additional people to work the video computer. I am not even sure of everyone involved in those but I can recall seeing Phil Jordan, Brad Whitney, Chris Hanganu, Damien Evans, Jason Hamilton, Alica Lee and Frederic Manuel in the back along with those working the powerpoint computer.

GraceBibleNY.org Here is some interesting date for the period January 1 - August 31, 2023. We had 238,323 page visits in 184,999 sessions. This rate is down about 28% from 2022 which is down 79% from our high rate before Google algorithms were changed. Google search engine no longer even shows up in the top 10 referrals. I continue to encourage people to use other search engines such as duckduckgo. Yes, big tech does actively censor sites it does not like. The majority of people now access us through mobile devices (51%) and tablets(4%) instead of desktops / labtops (45%). That places even more importance on the website remaining simple in order to load quickly on those devices. We get accessed from people around the world nearly anywhere English is used except those that actively block conservative Christian sites such as China which now completely blocks us.

Sermon Notes, are the written notes of my sermons (not a transcript), are sent out to over 3,100 individual email addresses each week. That is a slight increase from 2022.

SermonAudio statistics: January 1 - August 31, 2023: Total audio plays - 9,3231: video plays - 3,071. Mobile plays - 2,755. Countries reached - 85. States reached - 48. Total lifetime audio plays: 48,171+. Total video plays: 8,026+.

The top listened to / watched sermons on SermonAudio from January 1 - August 31, 2023 were Music - Part 2 (172 - Aug, 17, 2003), Philosophical Foolishness (132 - June 27, 2010), Dating, Courtship & Marriage (111 - Sept. 14, 2003), Submission in the Home (101 - Jan. 15, 2023) & Leadership and Mercy (94 - Jan. 26, 2023). The top video sermons were The Example of Christ (85 - Jan 8, 2023), Resolving to Be Better - (75 - Jan., 1, 2023), The Priority of Loving Others (68 - Feb., 16, 2020), The People of God (64 - Nov., 20, 2022) and Our Lord, Immanuel (63 - Dec., 25, 2022)

YouTube statistics. YouTube differs from SermonAudio in having the entire service recorded and not just the sermon. In January 1 - August 31, 2023 there were 4,736 total views with a total watch time of 844 hours. Top sermons were *Honoring Marriage* (Jonathan Harris - 254), *Act Like Men* (Jonathan Harris - 159), *Victory in Christ's Suffering* (148), *The Responsibility of Husbands* (142) and *Resolving to Live Better* (139). Seven sermons had more than 100 views each.

Evangelism Report 2023

Members of GBC and our friends strive to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ in various public settings several times a week. We preach Christ crucified and resurrected using the law to bring the knowledge of sin.

During the warmer months, we try to evangelize 2-4 times a week on local state parks, public streets, fairs, venues, parades and wherever people gather. We share the Gospel in one-to-one conversations, hand out Gospel tracts, open-air preach and give a "ARE YOU A GOOD PERSON?" test in a booth type setting. We will also run evangelism training classes using the Way of The Master training materials.

2023 was a good year for us, praise God! Many people helped over the course of the year, including those who witnessed on their own with friends, family, co-workers, strangers and at various locations.

Once again, we were able to evangelize at different locations and events such as, but not limited to, the streets of the city of Poughkeepsie, Beacon, the Walkway Over the Hudson, the Ulster County Fair, St Patrick's Day Parade, 4th of July Parade, Wappingers Community Day and East Fishkill Community Day. We were able to pass out Gospel tracts, Bibles, dvds and share the Gospel with people one to one.

Our main areas of evangelizing weekly are the city of Poughkeepsie by DMV, Beacon and when weather permits, the Walkway over the Hudson. We hit these places 2-4 times a week. Beacon is exploding and is always a great place to go, especially towards the weekend when crowds are bigger. The Walkway is a great tourist spot that keeps increasing each year with the amount of people that attend. This past year did not disappoint with people seeming to be more receptive than years past.

We held a Way of the Master Basic Evangelism Course in which we were able to equip people to share the gospel using the law to bring the knowledge of sin. This is an 8-week course where you will learn to share the Gospel simply and confidently with family, friends, and strangers. Im starting this with our Youth Group on Wednesday night.

Our biggest event of the year is the evangelism booth at the Ulster County Fair in August, which lasts 6 days. We set up an "ARE YOU A GOOD PERSON" booth, and many people came out to help once again! Every year Brother Dave Leak comes down from New Hampshire to help every day. Sometimes he brings his daughters to help. Many people came out to help us! Praise God for His faithfulness and for providing laborers!

We will continue our efforts in 2024 to spread the Gospel to this lost and dying world. We plan on recording some one-to-one interviews. We're hoping through these videos, we can reach a larger audience on the internet. As we continue going to many of our regular locations, we hope to add other state and county parks and trips to NYC for open-air preaching. We will also be attempting to evangelize at local colleges and add more fairs. We will be going door-to-door in surrounding communities and setting up mini—Good Person tests/Prayer Stations in Beacon, Poughkeepsie and the Walkway.

Please keep us in prayer for more laborers & more opportunities to share the Gospel, boldness & utterance of speech and to fulfill Colossians 4:2-6. Thank you everyone who has come out to help us and to those that prayed for us. We need your prayers! Thank you Saints!

GBC YOUTH MINISTRY 2023

The goal of GBC Youth Ministries is to help our teens develop a Christ-like character. At the same time, we want them to enjoy the meetings, have time for socialization and be able to participate in some fun activities.

We meet Wednesday nights at 6:30pm with snacks and a lesson, grades 8th to 12th. They then go to free time where they make use our field and new basketball court for soccer, volleyball, basketball, etc. We also gained some teens from other churches.

We continued through the summer and finished up The Road Trip to Truth apologetics curriculum from Wretched. There are 13 video sessions, each broken into 4 segments. Each night we go over at least one segment.

The Road Trip to Truth curriculum is intended to equip participants for the onslaught of postmodern ideas they will encounter in an increasingly secular world. The goal of this study is to introduce students to many of the ideas and arguments they will likely face and to persuade them of the reality and defensibility of the Christian worldview.

We started back up on October 11 with an opening party and quick review. Our first lesson we discussed and watched videos on the occult and the origins and dangers of Halloween, followed up by a lesson on Reformation Day. We will then start up the Way of the Master Evangelism course.

This eight-session course includes the best of Season One plus brand new footage.

- 1. Cultivating Compassion for the Lost (30 mins)
- 2. Discovering Hell's Best Kept Secret (38 mins)
- 3. Learning to Overcome Fear (38 mins)
- 4. Practicing What You Preach (33 mins)
- 5. Crafting the Message (35 mins)
- 6. Answering the Top Ten Questions (50 mins)
- 7. Exposing the Myth of the Modern Message (35 mins)

Our Youth Group also met on Friday nights with our GBC Kids Club, grades 6th to 12th. We did snacks, lesson and game time. Last year (2022-2023) we went through Paul Washer's book, "Narrow Gate, Narrow Way.' We finished off with going through the 9 Tests of Your Salvation from 1 John.
